



## Rock Lake Christian Assembly: Dress Code

### **Dress and Grooming**

The intent of this dress code is to promote a healthy environment for spiritual growth. Any type of dress, behavior, or practice which creates a dangerous situation, infringes upon the rights or safety of others, is immodest, profane, portrays nudity, sexual innuendo, or is otherwise inappropriate for the Christian camp setting will not be allowed. Students and parents should consider the following questions when packing for camp:

- Does my clothing expose too much? (no)
- Does my clothing advertise something that is prohibited to minors? (no)
- Are there obscene, profane, drug-related, gang-related or inflammatory messages on my clothing? (no)
- Am I dressed appropriately for the weather? (yes)

### **SHIRTS and BOTTOMS**

- Shirts and tops with sleeves are preferred and recommended. Full length shirts are required of all students. Low cut tops, “see through” clothing, and/or thin strap garments (spaghetti straps) are not considered proper attire for the Christian camp environment. Clothing that advertises the use or sale of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products are not appropriate for the camp setting and will not be allowed. Shirts should not expose the midriff when the student raises his/her arms above the head. Clothing with holes is considered unacceptable if the holes are too revealing. Holes revealing undergarments and t-shirts where the sides are cut out are not allowed.
- Short shorts, spandex shorts, boxer shorts, pajama pants, and cutoffs are unacceptable.
- Costumes are always recommended and encouraged as long as they are appropriate to the setting.

### **UNDERGARMENTS**

- Undergarments should not be exposed because of tight and/or loose fitting clothing.

### **SWIMSUITS**

- Swimsuits should be modest. No “Speedo-style” for the boys. No exposed midriff for the girls.

### **SHOES AND ACCESSORIES**

- Shoes are required of all students and faculty. Students should wear proper fitting shoes or sandals. House slippers are not appropriate. It is recommended that every student bring with them a pair of tennis shoes for outdoor activities.
- Hats that advertise the use or sale of alcohol, drugs or tobacco products are not appropriate for our setting and will not be allowed.
